KEY DATES

- January 8** EDAs receive credentials
- January 18** Convention registration opens
- March 15** Deadline to submit EDA delegate lists using [online form](#). Unused credentials will be released back to Federal Office
- April 5** Convention registration closes

QUESTIONS + ANSWERS

How many delegates does each EDA get?

Delegates are based on the number of members your EDA has. All EDAs will get at least one regular and one youth delegate.

What if I want to be a delegate but don't get selected by my EDA?

You can register for convention without an EasyCode and a credential will be released to you after March 15, if any are available in your province. If no credential is available, your registration will be refunded.

What is an EasyCode?

It's a unique identifier you need to complete your registration that you get from your EDA or the Party.

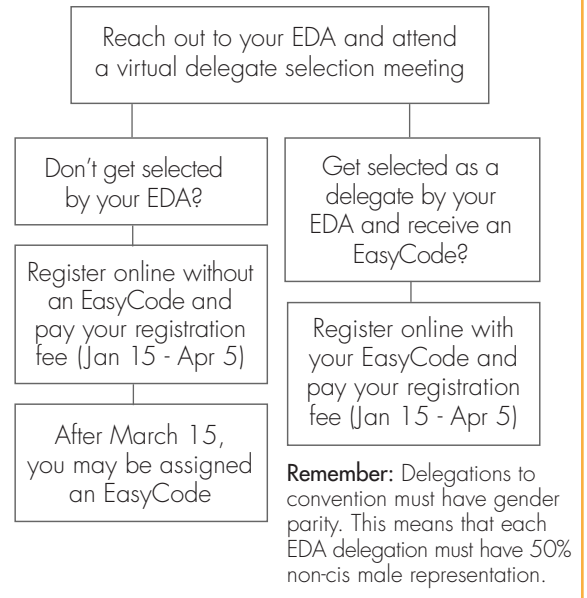
Can I register for convention once convention has begun?

No – you must register and pay your registration fee before registration closes on April 5.

EDAs normally have in-person meetings to select delegates to convention. How do we do this during a pandemic?

Delegate selection and resolution meetings should happen online. Federal Office can assist with setting up an online meeting and ensuring a secure voting process. Fill out the [online form](#) provided in the email and Federal Office staff will be in touch to assist.
